Here are the Resolutions of the Irish Branch for International Congress 2008: Voici les résolutions de la Branche Irlandaise pour Congrès International 2008:

The International Celtic Congress assembled in Aberystwyth, Wales, requests that appropriate recognition and status be accorded to Kernow, as has already been accorded in the case of Scotland and Wales.

Since the Government of France has given recognition to the ethnic minority of Serbia, namely the Kosovans, the International Celtic Congress assembled in Aberystwyth, Wales, requests of the said Government recognition of the Celtic minority within the national territory, namely the Bretons, especially through official recognition of and support for the Breton language.

KERNOW

The International Celtic Congress meeting in Aberystwyth petitions the Prime Minister to reject the plan from unelected South West Region quangos to construct 68,700 new properties in Kernow/Cornwall over the next twenty years and agree that Cornwall's housing strategy should be determined exclusively by democratically elected Cornish politicians, responsive to the needs and aspirations of the people whom they are elected to serve.

It can be reasonably anticipated that the proposed increase in the volume of housing will attract even more inward migration than that which has been experienced to date, thus further diluting and impacting adversely upon Cornwall's distinctive history, language and culture.
